Thank you for contacting Early Learning Coalition of Lake County. We have received your Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten application and are required to provide you with an overview of the VPK program, inform you of our child care resource and referral program, as well as other services that we offer at the Coalition. It is our goal to assist you in locating a quality child care program that meets your family's needs. Choosing an early care and education provider is one of the most important decisions that families make. It is important to choose a provider who meets the needs of your child and with whom you feel comfortable. Each family's situation and each child are unique; therefore, only you can best determine which program is right for you and your child.

Currently the Early Learning Coalition of Lake County serves Lake County children and families. Our hours of operation are 8:00 am – 5:00 pm Monday through Friday. Our database includes all legally operating providers (those that have met all state and local licensing or registration requirements). It is essential that you make at least one unannounced visit before making your child care selection. We also recommend you contact the Department of Children and Families licensing office (listed below) to review provider files prior to making a child care selection for your child(ren). #### **Woluntary Pre-Kindergarten**

VPK is a legislatively mandated program designed to prepare all of Florida's four-year-olds for kindergarten. VPK offers high quality education programs with a focus on early literacy. VPK is FREE for all children who reside in Florida and will turn four on or before September 1st of the school year. Private and public child care providers offer VPK programs giving parents optimal choice.

What You Need to be a Provider:

- Must be licensed or accredited through a pre-approved accrediting agency
- Have a person on staff with a valid Directors Credential
- Offer 540 instructional hours during the school year

For 11 children you must have one Lead Teacher with the following:

- CDA/CDAE or
- AA or higher degree in child development or
- AA or higher in any field with 6 credit hours in early childhood education and 480 hours experience in teaching age birth to 8.
- AND successfully complete the VPK emergent literacy training course online
- AND have a 5 year current level II background clearance and affidavit of good moral character.

For 12-20 children in one class, you must have one additional adult with a 5 year current Level II background clearance and an affidavit of good moral character.

#### **VPK Mission**

To ensure that all children are intellectually, emotionally, physically and socially ready to enter school and ready to learn, fully recognizing the crucial role of parents as their child's first teacher.

#### What is School Readiness?

The first day of Kindergarten is a scary experience for any five year old. They hold Mommy or Daddy's hand and walk bravely into a new world where they have to let go of that hand. Are they ready for this new world of expectations, rules, and challenges? Not all children are truly ready to learn when they get to Kindergarten. In this day and age, children need an extra boost to fully succeed.

No child should be left behind because they do not have the pre-literacy skills or because they do not know how to sit still for lesson time. A child's development takes place in several areas: cognitive, language, social, emotional, and physical. Development begins in the womb. 85% of the child's brain is developed by the age of five. We need to be there for our youngest children to give them the tools and skills they need to do more than get by. Our children need to succeed! Although the parent is the child's first teacher, both the parent and the child care provider need the resources and support to help the children reach their full potential.

The School Readiness program, which is funded by state and federal dollars, is a program designed to offer financial assistance to those families who are struggling to pay for child care.

#### **Family Services Department**

The Family Services Department is ready to assist parents with obtaining valuable information relating to child care services and many other services throughout Lake County. Our Family Services Specialists are available to meet with parents to assist with determining eligibility for the School Readiness Program, as well as the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Program. The Family Services team provides a streamline approach for parents seeking child care information, child care assistance and family assistance referrals in Lake County.

#### **School Readiness Services**

To qualify for subsidized child care services, the family must be at or below 150% of the federal poverty level or participate in a One Stop Career Center Program. We also offer child care for children in Protective Services or the foster care system.

#### **Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Services**

The Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten program is available to all eligible four year old children in Florida. To be eligible for VPK, the child must be four on or before September 1st of the program year.

#### **Quality Initiatives**

The Early Learning Coalition provides a wide array of quality initiative services to Lake County Providers and is committed to providing quality programs to the children and families in our area. Early education professionals are the key to the success of our quality programs.

<u>TRAINING:</u> The Coalition receives State funds allocated to local Quality Initiatives. The Coalition offers a variety of training opportunities throughout the year for Lake County parents and providers through this Quality Initiative Program. Also, the Coalition chooses to spend those Quality Initiative dollars to promote and enhance the early education/care environment by providing professional reimbursements to early childhood providers seeking a degree in the field of early childhood education.

The Coalition also offers trainings as well as learning resources for child care providers that cover infants and toddlers, that include phonemic awareness, to VPK standards for four year old children. The Coalition also contracts with certified trainers to provide quality First Aid and CPR training for our teachers and directors of child care facilities and family child care homes. The training includes the proper techniques that should be used on children or adults. ELCLC providers throughout the County volunteer to host a training at their facilities that are held on the first Saturday of each month. Registrations with payment must be sent to the Coalition offices five days prior to the training.

<u>PROGRAM ASSESSMENTS:</u> As part of the Coalition's Quality Initiatives program, the Early Education Specialists conduct routine environmental rating assessments as well as health and safety checks as required by Florida state guidelines.

<u>RESOURCES:</u> The Specialists can provide directors and teachers with valuable resources for the classrooms. The Coalition has a resource room which is open on specific dates and times, in order for providers to come to the Coalition office and shop with "Resource Bucks" that have been earned by attending Coalition trainings and conferences. The resource room is supplied with a large variety of books, resources and materials that can be used to facilitate learning or make fun and interesting lesson plans for the children.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE: The Early Education Specialists provide on-going technical assistance for our child care facilities as needed.

<u>INCLUSION SERVIES:</u> The Coalition's mission and vision is to ensure that all children in the Lake County and surrounding areas reach their learning, and fullest growth and developmental potential. Through the Quality Initiatives program, the Coalition has added two Inclusion Specialists whose main focus is to provide Inclusion services for our providers and parents that include:

- Developmental screenings and assessments,
- Child /classroom observations.
- Inclusion coaching and mentoring for preschool/child care providers,
- Technical assistance with techniques and approaches to early childhood special education,
- Referrals to community organizations that provide therapeutic & educational services to families with children at risk of developing developmental delays or disability, and
- Advocacy for children with special needs.

## A Quality Checklist For Evaluating Early Learning Programs Observation Tips

#### Make an informed decision

Like any parent, your first concerns are for the safety, health, and welfare of your child. Every program will have positive characteristics, but only you can decide which things are most important for you and your child.

#### Look and Listen

You can tell a great deal by observing and listening to what is going on in the classroom or home. Do the children seem happy and were they enjoying activities? Do the teachers seem to be loving, nurturing, and responsive to all children in their care? Are problems handled promptly and appropriately? Do the teachers seem like people you can trust with the health, happiness and well being of your child? Is this a place where you would feel good about your child spending many hours each day?

#### Ask questions

If you have any questions or concerns, write them down as they occur to you. Ask for an opportunity to have your questions answered or your concerns addressed.

#### Pay attention to your instincts

You know your child best. Pay attention to any feelings of uneasiness you may have experienced during your visit. Can you picture your child in this setting? Were the toys and activities you observed the kinds your child would enjoy? If your child was with you on your visit, what was his reaction? Keep in mind that children respond in their own unique ways to new situations. Also, don't rule out other factors that could influence your child's reaction (for example, being hungry, tired, having a natural fear of new people or places). Trust your instincts and your ability to make wise decisions for your child.

#### When cost is a factor

Carefully weigh the "pros" and "cons" of each teacher and facility that you visited. Decide which facility satisfies the greatest number of your priorities at a rate that you can afford. Keep in mind that the highest cost doesn't always guarantee the best teacher and facility. Likewise, the least expensive rates do not necessarily mean poor teachers and facilities.

#### A good choice

Now that you have done your homework and some careful thinking, you are ready to make your choice. Remember, selecting and placing your child in an early learning program is just the beginning. You will want to talk to the new teacher often and make occasional visits to ensure that your child is safe and happy and that your decision was the right one.

#### **Definition of Terms**

#### **Provider Type:**

**Licensed Child Care Facility** – A child care facility providing child care for more than five children unrelated to the operator and which receives a payment, fee, or grant for any of the children receiving care, wherever operated, and whether or not operated for a profit. Licensed by the Department of Children and Families, F.S. Section 402.305.

**Licensed Family Child Care Home** – An occupied residence in which child care is regularly provided for children from at least two unrelated families and which receives a payment, fee, or grant for any of the children receiving care, whether or not operated for a profit. Licensed by the Department of Children and Families, F.S. Section 402.313.

**Licensed Large Family Child Care Home** – An occupied residence in which child care is regularly provided for children from at least two unrelated families and which receives a payment, fee, or grant for any of the children receiving care, whether or not operated for a profit and which has at least two full-time child care personnel on the premises during the hours of operation. Licensed by the Department of Children and Families, F.S. Section 402.3131

**Public School Exempt** – A provider with the Lake County Public School System, governed by the Department of Education, F.S. Section 402.3025.

**Religious Exempt** – A faith based child care provider who is exempt from licensure under F.S. Section 402.316. These programs are offered through religious organizations and include a spiritual component as part of the child care program.

**Accredited** – A licensed child care center, home or public school who has applied to a national early childhood association and has successfully met certain health and safety requirements, curriculum and adult child ratios.

**Gold Seal** – An accredited private or public pre-kindergarten provider facility who has applied to the State of Florida and has received a Gold Seal Quality Care designation under F.S. Section 402.281.

#### **Class information for VPK Program**:

**School Year**: Consists of 540 instructional hours; program operates from August through June. Hours may vary depending on school or private center.

**Semester**: Consists of 540 hours, all day sessions for 90 days; program operates from August through January or January through June.

Summer: Consists of 300 instructional hours; program operates from June through August.

Title I: Combination of VPK State funds and Federal Title I funds to provide full day, full year to qualified students.

#### **Lead Instructor's Credential Level:**

AA/AS – A person who holds an Associate of Arts or Science Degree in an early education or related field.

BA/BS – A person who holds a Bachelor of Arts or Science Degree in an early education or related field.

MA/MS - A person who holds a Masters of Arts or Science Degree in an early education or related field.

**CDA** – Child Development Associate, is an individual who has successfully completed the CDA assessment process and has been awarded the CDA credential.

**CDAE** – Child Development Associate Equivalency, is an individual who has successfully completed the CDAE assessment process and has been awarded the CDAE credential.

Certified Teacher— A person who holds a valid teaching certificate for the State of Florida.

**FCCPC** – Florida Child Care Professional Credential, is an individual who has successfully completed the Birth through Five Florida Child Care Professional Credential Training Program and has been awarded a FCCPC credential.

#### **VPK Provider Kindergarten Readiness Rate:**

The VPK Provider Kindergarten Readiness Rate measures how well a VPK Provider prepares four-year-olds to be ready for kindergarten based on the Florida Kindergarten Readiness Screener (FLKRS). *The maximum possible 2012-2013 readiness rate is 100.* Readiness rates are calculated for all VPK providers that served at least four children who

- were in attendance for at least 70-percent of either the School Year or Summer VPK program (have substantially completed the program)
- participated in the FLKRS kindergarten screening.

## Florida's Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Program To be eligible for the VPK program, a child must reside in Florida and be four years old on or before September 1, 2014. A child remains eligible for the VPK program until the beginning of the school year for which the child is eligible for admission to kindergarten in a public school. A child is eligible to be enrolled in either: a school year program (540 instructional hours) or a summer program (300 instructional hours). A parent of each eligible child may enroll the child in one of the following programs: A school year pre-kindergarten program delivered by a private pre-kindergarten provider. A school year pre-kindergarten program delivered by a public school. A summer pre-kindergarten program delivered by the public school system or a private pre-kindergarten provider. Every school district is required by law to deliver the summer VPK program for every eligible child wanting to participate and who was not served in a school year program. The summer program will begin in the Summer of 2015. Parental Right and Responsibilities **Rights** Responsibilities • To enroll my child with an eligible provider or To find an eligible provider or school willing to school of my choice, subject to the provider's or enroll my child. school's agreement to admit my child.

- To be free from the provider or school requiring me to pay any fee or charge for the VPK program.
- To have the provider or school admit my child in the VPK program without requiring me to enroll my child (or pay) for additional services (e.g., full-day, extended-day, or wrap-around services).
- To receive VPK services for my child without discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin.
- To provide transportation for my child to and from the VPK program, although some providers or schools may offer transportation.
- To follow the provider's or school's attendance policy.
- To verify my child's attendance each month.
- To allow my child, after completing the VPK program, to be screened for readiness to enter kindergarten in order to confirm the VPK program's effectiveness.
